Established in 1897 the Wagga Wagga Swimming Club Inc is one of the oldest Swimming Clubs in NSW. The Club originally trained at Wagga Beach before moving from the river to the original pool in the late 1950s and eventually the new Oasis Aquatic Centre which opened in July 2003. The Club celebrated its 125-year anniversary in 2022/23.

With a strong Committee, a dedicated group of volunteers including accredited technical officials (assisted by an electronic scoreboard) and an internationally experienced Head Coach the Club is one of the premier swimming clubs in region NSW.

Our recent summer season was one of the most successful in recent years with a mix of existing, new and returning members participating in a range of social and competitive events.

Our official program includes Club Nights which prepare club members (under race conditions) for the many school, zone and regional carnivals and internal Club Championships.

In addition to hosting our own Long Course (50 metre pool) meet in November and Short Course (25 metre pool) meet in July each year the Club under the guidance of Head Coach Gennadiy Labara participates in many regional carnivals. We also regularly send our swimmers to NSW Country Championships, NSW State Championships, National Championships and International Meets. Recent performances include our Club swimmers exceeding personal and Club expectations securing medals, top ten finishes and Personal Best times across a range of age groups and events.

The Club has a strong focus on encouraging, supporting and developing social and personal engagement for all members from our youngest swimmers to our valued life members.
